- Day 1** **Travel to Albuquerque, NM**
Land in Albuquerque, NM, and travel to Santa Fe
Evening orientation program
- Day 2** **Acequia Introduction**
Walk the “Mother Ditch,” learn about the Acequia water system
Visit the oldest church in use in North America, San Miguel Mission
Introduction to multicultural history and culture of Santa Fe
- Day 3** **Local Community Work Day**
Work at local Community Center and lunch with community
Community garden, workshops, and clean up
- Day 4** **Farm Work Day**
NMSU farm in Alcalde and/or Tesuque Pueblo
Organic and traditional farming and permaculture
- Day 5** **Taos Work Day**
Introduction to Taos Pueblo
Arroyo Seco community garden project and lunch with community
- Day 6** **Indigenous Community Work Day**
Hamaatsa Center for Indigenous Learning – Santo Domingo Pueblo
Land restoration, water conservation, and adobe construction
Meal/s on-site and optional campfire
- Day 7** **Travel to Albuquerque, NM**
